# Will You Try These Ways to Protect Your Customers and Your Health?



**GLOVES** protect your skin from chemicals.



**MASKS** protect your lungs from acrylic and gel powder and nail filing dust.



**GLASSES** protect your eyes from splashing chemicals and fingernail clippings.



Use **BOTTLES** that do not leak and keep bottles closed to protect your lungs from chemicals. Label all containers.




Use a **VENTILATION MACHINE** to pull chemical vapors away from you.



**CLOSED METAL CONTAINERS** protect your lungs from evaporating chemicals.
